Baobab Trust Group was formed in 2003 by financial services professionals to provide independent and personalised offshore trust and corporate services to clients.

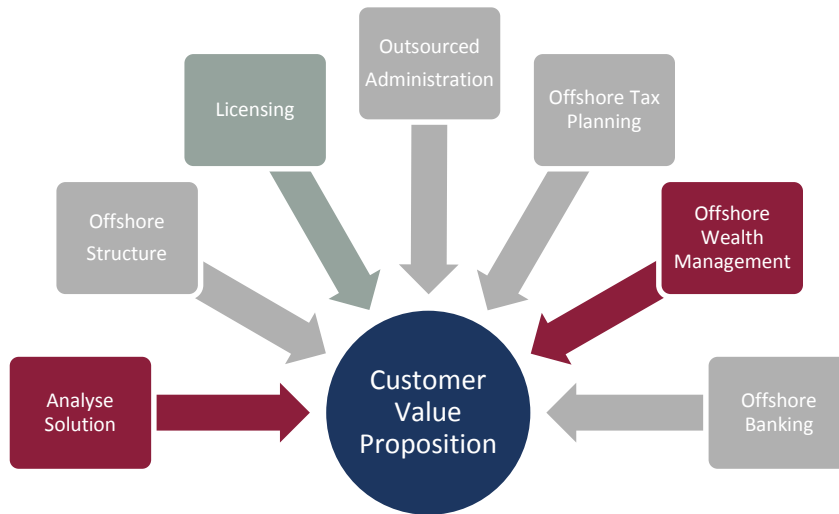

About Mauritius

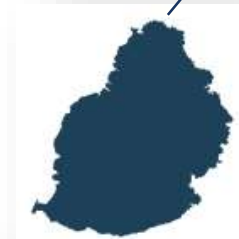

Corporate
